





















THE PALESTINE FLAG


The flag of Palestine is a tricolour of three equal horizontal stripes (<u>black</u>, <u>white & green</u>) overlaid by a <u>red</u> triangle issuing from the hoist. This flag serves as a powerful emblem of Palestinian identity and unity, representing their resilience, aspirations for peace, and their ongoing struggle for self-determination.




DRAW THE FLAG



Masjid al-Aqsa. meaning "the Farthest Mosque." is the place where the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) made his miraculous Night Journey (Isra) from Mecca to Jerusalem. and from there ascended to the heavens (Mi'raj). Masjid al-Aqsa isn't just a single building: it's part of a larger compound known as the Haram al-Sharif. Masjid al-Aqsa is the third holiest mosque in Islam. It is a very blessed and important place for Muslims








Palestine is famous for its embroidery known as "tatreez." It is a cherished and intricate form of art that holds deep cultural significance. These designs serve as a form of visual storytelling, preserving Palestinian heritage and identity.

THE RESISTANCE (...)



Watermelon is grown across Palestine and has become an icon of resistance. Since 1967, the Israeli government has banned any public displays of the Palestine flag. Sharing the same colours as their flag (red. green, white and black) - the watermelon became a subtle method of protest against the suppression of Palestinian culture and identity.


